Farber Hebrew Day School is excited to present our ChildCare programming for our “Terrific Toddlers”.

The following criteria are used to determine a child’s readiness to our Terrific Toddler program:

1. Child is the age of one year old by September 1st
2. For students enrolled for a full day, child is beginning to show interest in ONE afternoon nap

This is a chance for your toddler to engage in the world around them with activities that are just right for their age. Singing, dancing, playing, mess-making, baking, Jewish themes and holidays and the support in the development of gross motor skills, are all integral parts of the young two’s learning experience.

Young children acquire new skills and form their first friendships in a safe, warm, and nurturing environment. Our program is carefully crafted to facilitate your child’s educational journey, always in tune to their individual way of learning and processing information. We offer center-based activities reflecting Jewish Holidays and values, seasons of the year, and awareness of the world around us.

Our program uses hands-on exploration and social interaction in safe, engaging surroundings to help your one to two year old learn about his or her expanding world. Through the guidance of our early childhood development professionals, toddlers enjoy learning experiences that promote their blossoming independence and social skills, and foster self-confidence.

Because trusting relationships are so important, caregivers strive to ensure that each infant or toddler in our center or home has a primary caregiver throughout the day.
